Barral's Manual diagnostics - Manual Thermal diagnostics

This course will give a step by step introduction to the diagnostic system of Jean-Pierre Barral. During the many years of working with Barral we have observed why his treatments are in many cases exceptionally successful: He uses the single techniques in a very specific mode based on a detailed manual evaluation of the individual client. In a certain way the microscopic evaluation is even more important than the treatment itself.

There are three main themes for this course: global listening, local listening and „manual thermal diagnosis“. We will practice Barral's tests. We will study how he uses the different parts of the hand for diagnostic tests. And we will explore alternative possibilities additional variations. Special emphasis will be on learning Manual Thermo Diagnosis. Martin Gütthlin, M.D. will help using the ultrasound to check our findings at the screen. Additionally we will introduce some techniques for the treatment of the liver and the kidneys. We will check the efficiency of this techniques at the screen of the ultrasound.

Advanced Visceral Manipulation

With this new course Jean-Pierre Barral introduces new techniques for Visceral Manipulation. He opens a new perspective in evaluating the motion of organs, by including neural and vascular supply and by testing and treating the viscoelasticity of certain organs. He also plans to pay attention the way, how organ manipulation may influence the endocrine and exocrine processes within the human organism.

The course follows the material that is presented in the three DVDs about Advanced Visceral Manipulation produced by our [munich group media](http://www.munich-group-media.com) (www.munich-group-media.com). There will be some new material about pancreas and spleen. And there will be a lot of new material about the large intestine, for example about the so-called "appendiculo – ovarian flirt" and the "Cannon-Böhm" point. The course will also include information about a more successful dimension of treating the inner thorax:

- Differential diagnosis of the lungs, the heart, the bronchi and the liver.
- Treatment of the pericard and the heart
- Treatment of the aorta and the vena cava superior
- Treatment of the right bronchus, the junction of the vena azygos and the vena cava.

And last not least Jean-Pierre will show some of his "classical" modalities of Visceral Manipulation by including the clients movement within an elegant modality of combining refined touch simultaneously with the active participation of the client.

This course is about variations of the well-known classical visceral approach and about new insights Jean-Pierre has had during a permanent practical research within 40 years of practice.

Visceral Manipulation – Organs of the abdomen- Part 1
(liver, stomach, gall bladder, duodenum and related sphincters)

This new format of our visceral courses focuses during the first part (three days) on liver, stomach, gall bladder, duodenum and small intestine. There will be clear instruction for anatomical topology, for detailed tests of mobility and motility of the organs, for their relations with vessels and sphincters. We will learn how to distinguish the role of ligaments and fascial envelopes. The goal of the course is to understand the meanwhile „classical“ tests and treatment techniques within the context of new concepts, for example the viscoelasticity of some organs.

Essentials of cranial work

In this practical course we will explore the cranial field. We will start with the neurocranium and see all kind of techniques that are partly old but also some new techniques to treat the neurocranium. We will discuss some pathologies like tinnitus, dizziness, headache, migraine and others and give the osteopathic possibilities.

In the second part we will look at the viscerocranium, we will look at all the bones with their specific intraosseous and extra osseous articulations. We will train the techniques and discuss pathologies like sinusitis, trigeminal neuralgia, TMJ and orthodontic problems and others.

This second part follows the same emphasis of the first part: the traditional modes of working with the organs will be combined with the new perspectives and techniques that Barral has developed recently. Part of the course is about the key techniques for the kidney, to prepare for the following courses about urogenital structures.

“Biofilm” – Relations between metabolic diseases. Practical applications for manual practitioners

This course is a continuation of the course last year. However this time there will be much more practice. The course is open for newcomers as well as for those, who did already a course with Bruno Donatini and want to know more about practice.

Gastro-duodenal emptying disturbances are very frequent. They induce small bowel as well as large bowel dysbioses leading to chronic inflammation, metabolic disease, weakened immunity, some cancers and perhaps depression.

This cascade of complications can be prevented with appropriate dietary intake, physical exercises, electrostimulation of the left vagal nerve and abdominal osteopathy.

The measure of exhaled hydrogen or of methylacetate enables to distinguish three main types of dysbioses (bacterial overgrowth).

Gastroduodenal anatomy, visualized by echography, will be demonstrated as well as osteopathic maneuvers and electrostimulation of the left vagal nerve.

Echography confirms the diagnosis, the impact of osteopathic maneuvers and the amplitude of gastro-duodenal emptying. The elasticity of the liver gives hints on the inflammation.

Dietetic advices and use of essential oils or medicinal mushrooms will also be provided.

Fascial and membrane technique: Key Structures of Fascia and Membranes – Manual diagnostics and treatment

In this course Peter Schwind relates his practical experience of working with fascia to the latest news from the scientific field. He introduces diagnostic items for the manual evaluation of fascia and membranes for the widespread typology of tissues: We will explore in which ways the fascial system connects the main components of the parietal, visceral and craniosacral systems. We will study the topography of the „inner bridges“ between the various cavities inside the torso and the cranium. And we will pay attention to the connections between the torso and the extremities.

For the trunk: Special emphasis of this course will be given to the manual evaluation and treatment of the spatial subdivisions of the thorax, abdomen and pelvis.

For the extremities: Special emphasis will be given to the distinction between deep fascia of the muscle, intermuscular septa and interosseous membranes.

For the transitional areas between trunk and extremities: Special emphasis will be given to the microstructures around the joint capsules and their role within the hydrostatic pressure system of joints.

Visceral Manipulation – Organs of the Pelvis

This course focuses on the restriction of the organ motion within the pelvis. We will be dealing with the kidneys for quite some time. The very special topographical position of these organs behind the peritoneum requires detailed study, that enables us to work with caution and precise anatomical orientation.

In theory and practice we will get familiar with the position, the visceral articulations and physiological movement of the kidneys. We will search for adhesions and related bony restrictions. We will understand contraindications and we will be learning - step by step - how to influence the mobility and the motility of this very important organs.

Then we will continue with the perineum, the bladder and the uterus. At first we will be dealing with the „theory“, to be able to practically work with great care and subtleness.

In this course we also will get to know how to perform precise tests for the articulation between sacrum and coccyx and the related traditional and new steps for treatment in practice.

Within the three days of this course we will exclusively learn tests and techniques, that are applied externally. Internal techniques for the cervix and the prostate will not be taught.

Inner dimensions of the human pelvis and their connections with the musculoskeletal system

This course is a two days follow-up of Thomas Sonleitner's course about visceral manipulation of the of the pelvic organs.

Laura and Peter Schwind have worked together to update the course material with the latest findings in Visceral Manipulation. Barral's concept sees the neck of the uterus as the keystone of an arch that receives the motion and pressures of the column of organs. The neck of the uterus distributes the weight towards the pelvic bones, the bony framework. There is an analogy with the system described by Karpanj, which shows how he gravity line comes to the promotorium of the sacrum and how the forces go to the hip. The uterus protects the bladder from too much pressure, which can be one of the factors, that cause incontinence in women.

In man the prostate has to fulfill a job, that can in a certain way be compared with the uterus. And for both organs - prostate and uterus - we have to keep an eye on the coccyx and the related ligaments. We have to be aware that the nervus pudendus is directly related to the sacrospinous ligament. And we also have to be aware that the cranial system as an inner connection with the deep pelvic elements via the dura mater spinalis. Laura will cover additional aspects of the visceral pelvis, that add to the basic course about visceral manipulation of the urogenital system and she will include the connections with the vertebral spine and the hip joints.

This course is practically oriented. All treatment techniques are introduced by clear anatomical description, including palpation-, tests and also internal manipulation.

Manipulation of cranial nerves and the main cranial vessels

Independent from the traditional craniosacral approach Jean Pierre Barral (D.O.) and Alain Croibier (D.O.) have developed their own diagnostic and treatment concept for the cranium. On the contrary to the traditional cranial approach focusing on the bony and membranous dysfunctions, their emphasis lies on treating the brain and the cranial nerves and vessel.

This course is meant to expand the traditional cranial concept but may be seen as a self sufficient approach to the cranium.
